RECOMMENDED CARE & MAINTENANCE CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

It's important to properly care for and maintain decorative graphic marking films to achieve long-lasting results.

**Wait approximately 7-14 days prior to cleaning freshly installed decorative window films.*

RECOMMENDED CLEANING SOLUTION

- In a Clean Spray Bottle add the following ingredients:
 - Clean Water (*Distilled water is preferred*)
 - No more than 2 tsp. of mild dish detergent or baby shampoo (*Joy®, Dawn®, Johnson & Johnson®*)
 - 1 tbsp. of Isopropyl Rubbing Alcohol
 - Shake to combine ingredients
- Recommended Cleaning Tools
 - Non-Abrasive Cleaning Materials
 - Soft, clean microfiber towels or sponges
 - Soft, rubber window squeegee - designed not to scratch window films

CLEANING PROCEDURE

- Spray healthy amount of the recommended cleaning solution from the top of the window toward the bottom of the window.
- With gentle pressure - use a soft, clean microfiber towel, sponge, or soft rubber window squeegee to clean the surface of the window film.
 - Begin at the top of the window film and work down toward the bottom of the window film.
- With gentle pressure - use a soft, clean microfiber towel to dry away any residual moisture.

Do not utilize the following cleaning solutions or procedures, as these may damage or shorten the life of the decorative window film.

- Don't power wash or pressure wash decorative window film.
- Don't use Ammonia-based window cleaners.
 - Repeated use may dry the film out over time.
- Don't use excessive amounts of soaps or detergents.
 - These will likely leave an excessive amount of residue or streaks.
- Don't use caustic chemicals and cleaners.
 - These could potentially discolor or damage the window film.

INTERIOR APPLICATIONS

- Only clean as needed.

EXTERIOR APPLICATIONS

- Regularly clean decorative window films to remove environmental contaminants that may reduce the service life of or permanently stain the window film.
- Decorative window films that are in regular contact with overspray from ground level irrigation systems will likely fail or become permanently stained.
 - If this scenario is likely, consider applying the decorative window film to the interior (*second-surface*) of the window.
 - ORAFOL Americas will not warrant decorative window films when regularly subjected to irrigation system overspray.
