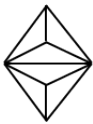
Product Construction

ORALITE® ID Tape is composed of cube corner (microprism) retroreflective elements integrally bonded to a flexible, smooth-surfaced tough and weather resistant UV stabilised polymeric film. The reflective material is welded to a UV stabilised polymeric film to protect the prism surfaces from dirt and moisture. The product is made from the reflective film ORALITE® 2033.
